BACHELOR OF SCIENCE

Quarter Credit Hours Required = 180

The Bachelor of Science degree in Private Sector Accounting is designed to meet the needs of those students who desire an in-depth knowledge and understanding of accounting and who intend to seek employment in the accounting field. Graduates from this program will be able to seek positions in private industry such as financial accountant, cost accountant, budget accountant, or internal auditor. Graduates from this program will also be able to seek governmental or not-for-profit accounting positions. This program solidifies the student's understanding of accounting theory and emphasizes the student's ability to apply advanced accounting theories in practice.

Upon successful completion of this program, students should be able to

- analyze accounting, financial, and statistical data for use in management decision making;
- interpret financial statements and utilize computerized systems to process financial data;
- identify planning and completion procedures of individual and corporate taxation;
- apply advanced accounting theorems to practical scenarios;
- evaluate accounting concepts related to governmental and not-for-profit accounting;
- critique auditing standards as they relate to private industry; and
- coordinate a successful job search.
